# Rwanda Abakundakawa Women Coffee I FTO

This Fairtrade and organic certified washed coffee comes from the Abakundakawa Washing Station, a cooperative founded in 1999. The name "Abakundakawa" translates to "those who love coffee." Around 20 years ago, Abakundakawa established the women's group Hingakawa, which means "grow coffee" and now includes 584 women. Their mission is to promote equality and combat poverty.

The coffee farmers of the Abakundakawa cooperative harvest ripe coffee cherries on the volcanic slopes of the mountainous Gakenke district in Rwanda. The unique microclimate, high altitude, and fertile volcanic clay soil contribute to the coffee's balanced sweetness and floral, fruity notes.
