The HAMBELA WAMENA BENTI NENKA Washing Station is one of the three washing stations of Tega & Tula in the Guji region, where they work with 3,500 smallholder farmers to promote sustainable agricultural practices and ensure exceptional coffee quality.

The name „Hambela Wamena“ originates from the Oromo language and means „Land of the Survivors.“ The washing station is located at an altitude of 2000 meters and covers an area of about 1.2 hectares. This coffee comes from a carefully hand-picked and processed micro-lot. It grows in fertile clay soil, which promotes plant growth.
