The Hambela Wamena Buku Saysa Washing Station is one of the three washing stations of Tega & Tula in the Guji region, where they work with 3,500 smallholder farmers to promote sustainable agricultural practices and ensure exceptional coffee quality.

The name „Hambela Wamena“ comes from the Oromo language and means „Land of the Survivors.“ The washing station is located at an altitude of 2,300 meters and covers about 1.2 hectares. This coffee comes from a micro-lot that has been carefully hand-picked and processed. It grows in fertile clay soil, which favors plant growth.
